If you purchased supplies through the PTA, the additional items are marked with an *asterisk*. If you did not purchase supplies through the PTA, please purchase all items before the first day of school. Make sure that all notebooks and folders have the appropriate labels (Science, Math, etc.).

- ***5 Two-Pocket Folders in total (with bottom pockets only)***
 - Please label with your child's name and subject listed below
 - Blue (Math), Yellow (Reading/Writing), Green (Science), Red (Social Studies), Any Color/Design (Homework)
- ***1 Marble Composition Notebook (wide-ruled, black and white)***
- ***1 Shoebox-sized Clear Bin containing (about 14" L x 5" W x 8 "H)***
 - 4 packages of #2 sharpened pencils
 - 4" Protractor - Clear
 - 2 Glue Sticks
 - 1 Box of Crayons (24 count)
