

AMMS Personal Device Policy

If a student has a personal device during the school day, teachers and staff will:

1. Collect the device.
2. Bring the device to the front office with a post-it note with the student's name and grade level (if time allows).
3. If time does not allow, keep the device in a locked desk/drawer until dismissal, at which time they will bring the confiscated device to the front office.
4. All devices will need to be collected by a parent/guardian prior to 5:00pm.

The new board policy states that K-8 students are not allowed to access personal electronic devices during the school day. This includes:

- Before the 8:35 bell
- Lunch
- Recess
- Transitions
- During dismissal
- On the bus
- Any Non-Instructional Time

Personal Devices Include:

- Phones
- Non School-Issued Laptops
- Tablets
- Smart Watches
- Bluetooth Ear Buds/Air Pods
- Other Bluetooth capable devices

If a student is disrespectful and/or defiant when confiscating their device, a minor may be entered for that student.
