Dear Member of the Class of 2026 and Family,

Welcome back to what I know will be an amazing senior year! I hope that each of you has had a great summer filled with fun and relaxation and that you are looking forward to your senior year. I look forward to working with the members of the Class of 2026 to ensure a successful and exciting year as you begin to plan the next phase of your academic careers.

As part of your fall planning please note that the **Senior Parent School and College Counseling Night is on Wednesday September 3rd** at 6:30PM in Henderson Theater. Parents should mark their calendars for this very important event in which information about the college planning process will be shared.

Other things to note as we return to school:

- Included in this mailing is our 2025-2026 Calendar Handbook.
- Seniors should arrive at school no later than 8:05AM on **Wednesday, September 3, 2025**. Seniors will report to homeroom to begin the day. Dismissal will be at 12:34PM. Seniors will not attend school on September 4th. All grades will participate in Welcome Back Day on Friday September 5th which will be a full day and for seniors will include a class level mass and a college application workshop. The first day of classes will be on Monday, September 8, 2025.
- The Class of 2026 Photo will be taken on Wednesday, September 3, 2025. Students not in full compliance with the dress code will not be permitted to be in the class photo.
- **Members of the Class of 2026 who have not had senior portraits done must schedule an appointment to do so.** There have been many opportunities for students to be photographed on campus. Those who have not been photographed will have to go to Normandy Studio. If a senior has not been photographed, a previous year's photo will be used, if possible. If that is not feasible, the senior will not have an individual photo included in the 2025-2026 yearbook. If you have any questions please contact Ms. Meehan or Dr. Widdis.
- The school building will be open daily at 7:30AM. Students arriving early should report to the library or the dining hall. The library will remain open until 5:00PM each day.
- 2024-2025 Yearbooks will be distributed in homeroom in September to those who ordered them. Seniors do not need to order a 2025-2026 yearbook as all seniors receive a personalized copy of the yearbook.
- Seniors may be extended the privilege of early dismissal (after period 4d) only on days that their scheduled classes end before 2:34PM. Seniors must sign out in the main office prior to leaving the building and may not leave until the start of period 5. To participate once this privilege is granted each senior must return a senior early dismissal form signed by his parent or guardian. The form can be found on the 2026 Class Page.

As we return to school, I would like to take the opportunity to encourage seniors to continue to be involved in the many extracurricular and co-curricular activities offered at CBA. CBA's extracurricular activities provide a unique opportunity to nourish the whole person--mind, body and spirit.
