Definition of Professional Development: *Opportunities to learn, explore, and develop skills and/or methodologies to grow as an educator and further student learning.*

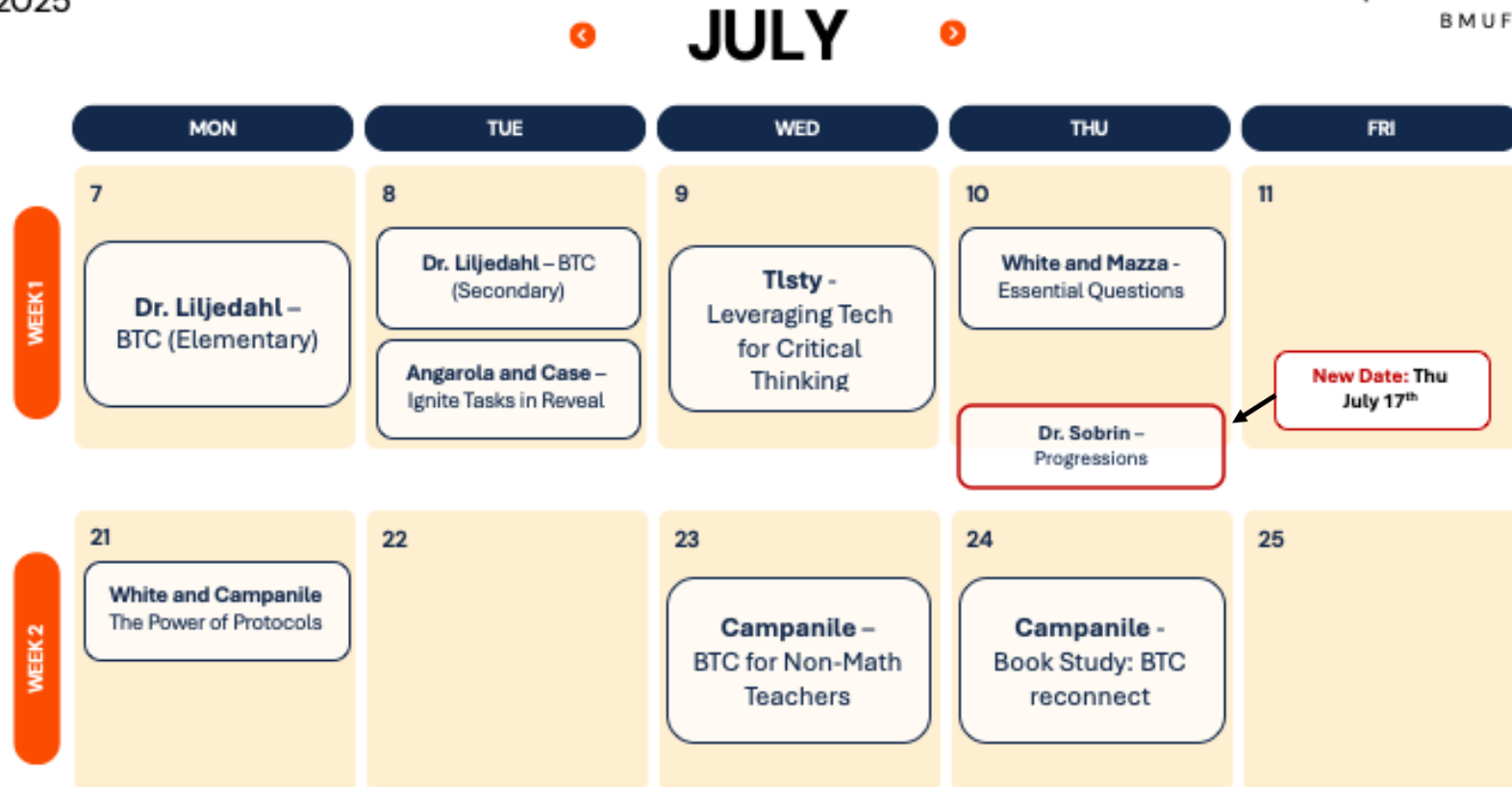
