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### **Braymer C-4 Sportsmanship Improvement Plan**

The Braymer C-4 Board of Education has drafted this plan for the purpose of formally improving our sportsmanship and its reputation.

The following will be implemented moving forward with the 2025-2026 school year with no exceptions:

- Training and professional development will be provided for administration to promote active supervision
- MSHSAA/NFHS Sportsmanship Course training will be required of all coaches
- Minimum of 1 admin on duty
- When available, law enforcement at home games.
- Braymer C-4 Sportsmanship Letter is posted on the District Website
- Visitor bus parking will be changed to allow alternative entrance/exit
- Detailed itinerary will be sent to visiting schools prior to the day of the game

#### Pre-game protocols:

- Before each contest, a PSA will be read aloud promoting sportsmanship and the possible consequences that go along with improper sportsmanship.
- Visiting teams will be shown the locations of their locker rooms via the administrator on-duty
- A banner will be posted in the gym promoting Sportsmanship

#### Post-game protocols

- Admin on duty will be present at, or near the handshake line.
- Braymer Coaches will be holding players in the locker room until all players are dressed and ready to leave as an entire team.

#### Spectator disciplinary Action Plan:

##### Phase 1: If a spectator is...

- Addressed by an official or administrator for undesired behaviors **a warning will be issued**
- Addressed a second time in the same event **removal from event and a 1 game suspension and placement in Phase 2.**
- Removed or ejected outside of the above listed will result in **a 2 game suspension and placement in Phase 2.**

##### Phase 2: If a spectator is...

- Addressed by an official or administrator for undesired behaviors **a warning will be issued**
- Addressed a second time in the same event **removal from event and a 2 game suspension and further suspension to be determined by the Sportsmanship Committee.**
- Removed or ejected outside of the above listed will result in **a 4 game suspension and placement in Phase 3.**

##### Phase 3: If a spectator is...

- Removed or ejected will result in **a suspension for the remainder of the season.**

**Disciplinary action is per sports season, across all levels of the sport in which the disciplinary action occurs.**

In effort to better our district we are currently working on sport-specific Codes of Conduct for each sport and activity. These Codes of Conduct will be followed by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators. A student, parent, and coach will also sign a code-of-conduct agreement.
