If your student is in the Career Programme (CP), the Diploma Programme (DP), the IB certificate, or any of our DP courses, they will be taking at least one DP exam this spring. The district pays for all exam fees for all DP students.

Sitting the **IB exams** in the spring is **10% of their local course grade** in PowerSchool. If a student misses any portion of their IB exam, it will affect their final grade in the class.

The **IB Diploma Programme Exam session is APRIL 30-MAY 20 2026**
These are worldwide exams set by the IBO that **cannot** be rescheduled.

Results come out in the first week of July. Students will receive their personal code and PIN in May so that they may check their results online.

If your student wants their results sent to a college or university they must request that by the end of May via google form on the CHS website.

Official results and certificates from the IB will be mailed home in September/October.

SAT/ ACT TEST SCORES

- Most Colleges are Test Optional
- **Not Required for Admission**
 - Not required for **UCs, CSUs, HBCUs**
- SAT/ ACT Scores if submitted are used as course placements.
- SAT/ACT Scores can be useful for **Merit Based Scholarships**
 - Useful for Ivy League Schools but in the majority of cases are **not Required.**

State Seal of Biliteracy

The state seal of biliteracy is an award given to graduating high school students who have studied and attained proficiency in English and one or more languages.

Eligibility:

1: Demonstrates English proficiency through ONE of the following methods:

- Complete all English arts for graduation requirements with an overall grade point average of 3.0 or above in those classes.
- Pass California standards assessment at the “Standards Met” or above in English language arts at the 11th grade.
- Score 480 on SAT

2: Demonstrates proficiency in one or more languages in addition to English proficiency through ONE of the following:

- Successfully complete a four-year course of study in a world language and attain an overall grade point average of 3.0 or above.
- Score at the proficient level or higher on a district exam through speaking, reading and writing.
