LEAD CENTER REGULATIONS

Violations will result in suspension and/or loss of driving privileges without refund and/or other disciplinary consequences (including legal).

Student drivers agree to save and hold harmless the Ray-Pec School District, LEAD Center and employees from any and all costs, liability, damages, or expenses (including legal services) or by reason of ay injury or damage to persons or property of any kind including even injury or death, arising as a result of this activity.
