



## **Design Standard Wall Panel Systems**

### **Purpose**

This design standard has the purpose of creating a consistent application of wall panel systems throughout the South San Francisco Unified School District, thereby achieving a standard of aesthetic quality, maintenance and performance throughout all renovation and new building projects.

### **Design Standard**

- Pre-finished decorative Laminate surfaced panels are appropriate for corridors, cafeterias, auditoriums and gymnasiums. These panels provide durability and ease of maintenance in high activity areas.
- Panels consist of high-pressure decorative laminate on MDF backing. Panels to be 7/16" minimum thick by 24" wide and can be wainscot height or full height.
- Laminate to be maple look selected from standard colors of Wilsonart, Formica or Pionite. Provide reveal between panels.
- Panels to use anodized aluminum trim and be attached per system manufacturer's requirements. Hardwood can be used at outside corners to match laminate finish.
- Specify fabricated panel with Class A Fire rating per ASTM E84.
