## Bond Program Update

Even though the Bond Office is working to close out the summer projects, we have kept the momentum going on our long term projects. Parkway Heights Middle School is now under full construction, and rapid progress is being made. SSFHS also is experiencing a construction burst, and three new buildings will be up and running before you know it. Finally, Buri Buri will soon be constructing new buildings as well. Final touches on the site work are being completed, and the concrete pads will be poured very soon.

Parkway's first of many new buildings slated for completion is Project Frog's 12PK typology which will house 12 new classrooms. SSFHS will receive a 12PK of classrooms as well as a 6PK science wing like El Camino's and a 2PK classroom building.

The Athletic Field at South San Francisco High School is in the final punch list stages, and the installation of the four (4) Musco lights which will illuminate the track and field is set for next month.

In retrospect, the Bond Office has completed several of the Measure J projects. The solar project is up and running, and all the new play structures have been installed at the elementary schools except at Buri Buri, when their new ones will be installed after the new campus construction. ADA Path of Travel upgrades have been added to 8 of the elementary campuses. Two phases of modular building

have been completed for a total of over 30 new classrooms, 6 new libraries and 9 Exploratoriums at 7 SSFUSD sites. Next summer we will wrap up the Modulars Phase portion of the Measure J Bond program with new classrooms, libraries and exploratoriums at Junipero Serra, Los Cerritos and Sunshine Gardens.

Despite the upcoming holiday season, construction will continue at the three main sites while preliminary design work continues for the Martin Modernization project, and the drawings for the Phase 3 Modular project at Sunshine Gardens, Junipero Serra and Los Cerritos make their way through DSA.

The Bond Office wishes the staff, students and neighboring communities of the SSFUSD campuses a very special and peaceful holiday season.

### **SSFHS Modular Update**
