SUMMER PROJECTS PROGRESS

Bond Program Update

The Bond Team celebrated two Groundbreaking Ceremonies this spring. On Earth Day, April 22, 2013, Project Frog hosted a Groundbreaking Ceremony for the Measure J Bond Modular Projects. Excitement is growing over the new classrooms and learning environments at Monte Verde, Skyline, Baden, El Camino and Alta Loma where the first Phase of Modulars will be completed this summer.

The Groundbreaking Ceremony for the new El Camino High School Field and Bleachers was held on May 15, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. There was high energy and excitement by the staff and the student body over their new athletic fields and bleachers. Interstate Grading & Paving, Inc. of South San Francisco has been selected to install both Fields and Bleachers at El Camino and South San Francisco High Schools.

The Measure J Bond program has rapidly mobilized key players this spring. Parsons is on-board as the Measure J Bond Program's Construction Manager and is taking the helm of the construction of the following twelve Measure J Projects: ADA Path of Travel projects at eight elementary school sites, High School athletic fields, Phases 1, 2 and 3 of the modular construction, South San Francisco High School's Classroom Replacement, Buri Buri Elementary School new construction, Martin Elementary School modernization, Parkway Heights Middle School

modernization, Science Rooms at El Camino High School, Alta Loma and Westborough Middle Schools, Spruce Elementary School Ramp and the remainder of the Playground Equipment Installation.

Consolidated Engineering, Inc. has been selected to conduct the material testing inspections for all the Phase 1 Modular Projects. Sposeto Engineering, Inc. is the contractor doing the eight elementary school sites' Path of Travel work. After receiving three very competitive prices, Sposeto came up on top with the lowest bid. All Path of Travel work, except Buri Buri, will be completed before the first day of the 2013-2014 school year. Also Suddath Moving Services was the low bidder for the professional moving services needed for the Phase 1 Modular Project. They will ensure all old classroom contents are safely moved and then situated in the new classrooms.
