Bond Program Update

The Bond Office has been busy with close out of the summer projects, the field dedication ceremony during the Bell Game on Nov. 16th, accelerated construction of the fall/winter projects and the design of next summer's projects.

The Measure J Bond Playground and ADA Path of Travel projects were formally closed by the Board in November and December, respectively. Notices of Completion for the playgrounds were recorded with the County at the beginning of December, and the Notices of Completion for the ADA Path of Travel will be recorded before the end of January. Miracle Playsystems and Sposeto Engineering deserve commendations for the outstanding work each did for the SSFUSD.

The Bond Office is working on complete close out of the Phase 1 Modular project. A host of documentation is required to ensure the District's full accessibility to warranties, operational and maintenance manuals as well as extra supplies.

On November 16, 2013, District staff, city dignitaries, delighted students and a deserving community packed the new bleachers at Colt Field for the ribbon cutting ceremony and the grueling match between South City's two rivals. Superintendent Alejandro Hogan introduced the Board members, and Board President Phil Weise thanked the community of South San Francisco for their tax dollars that

made this field possible. El Camino's Principal David Putney pumped up the crowd and then members from both the Colts' team and the Warriors proceeded to cut the ribbon. Both teams went on to play a great game with the Warriors outplaying the Colts 29-28.

Even with all of this activity, the Bond Office continues to move forward with the Design of the Phase 2 modulares as well as the last touches on the cornerstones of the Measure J Bond program: South San Francisco High School's two story 20 classroom building, Parkway Heights campus renovation and Buri Buri's completely new campus. 2013 was only a taste of what is to come. We look forward to a bigger and better Bond program for 2014. We hope the citizens of SSF and the students and staff of SSFUSD have a bigger and better New Year as well.
