School Safety

- **DO NOT** open doors for anyone – i.e. students or adults.
 - After the 7:25 the only entrance that can be used is the front office entrance.
- If you open the door for anyone you will be assigned ISS for a safety threat.
- Students who have someone open the door for them will also receive the same consequence.

Attendance Matters!!!

When a student misses 2 days a Month:

- Will have missed **20 days** of the year

When a Student Misses 4 Days a Month:

- Will have missed **40 days** of the year

Important Attendance Laws:

- 90 % Rule
- Truancy Law

Hall Passes

Expectation: You Have a Hall Pass If Not In Class

- Students are expected to remain in class during the first and last 10 minutes of class
- You **MUST** have a pass from your teacher **AND** your ID in the hallway. If you do not have both you will receive disciplinary consequences (**Out Of Area**)
- Use the bathrooms for your current pod's color bathroom pass

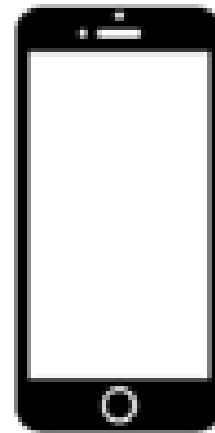
Students are NOT PERMITTED to go to the PARKING LOT during the school day including lunch or passing period

Electronic Device Policy

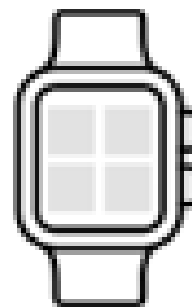
Purpose

As part of a statewide initiative to minimize distractions, promote academic achievement, and enhance student well-being, the State of Texas passed House Bill 1481 prohibiting students from using personal telecommunication devices during the school day, including passing periods and lunch.

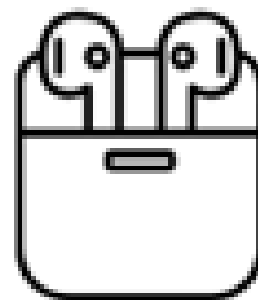
WHAT DEVICES ARE INCLUDED?



- CELL PHONES
- SMART WATCHES
- EARBUDS/AIRPODS



- HEADPHONES
- NON-DISTRICT ISSUED ELECTRONIC DEVICES



- SMART GLASSES
- ALL BLUETOOTH-ENABLED ACCESSORIES

Expectation

All devices are to be powered off and placed in the student's backpack, purse, or a bag from 7:20 AM to 2:35 PM. The use of personal communication devices is prohibited at all times, including during passing periods and at lunch.

AWAY FOR THE DAY

WHAT HAPPENS IF A STUDENT VIOLATES THE POLICY?

The Texas LAW requires school districts to administer disciplinary consequences if students violate the personal telecommunication device policy in schools. Each infraction is subject to the following:

- Confiscation of the device
- Return of the device at the end of the school day
- Parent notification
- Progressive discipline may include:
 - In-School Suspension (ISS), increasing with multiple offenses
 - possible placement at alternative education placement (AEP) after multiple offenses for persistent misbehavior

Honor Code

Students are responsible for academic integrity by

- Completing all assigned work, activities and tests honorably
- Avoiding cheating, copying others' work, or plagiarism
- Not using artificial intelligence tools such as but not limited to Chat GPT, Photo Math, etc.
- Not communicating with other students during exams

Honor Code - Consequences

1. Violation will be recorded in student's discipline record.
2. Students will receive a zero for the assignment and will not be allowed to retake or correct the assignment.
3. Students are also subject to receiving a U in conduct.
4. Students will receive ISS and/or other applicable consequences (including ineligibility in the next contest/game)
5. Students may be removed from Honor Societies (NHS, SNHS, NEHS, etc. And are not eligible for any final exam exemptions for the year.

Fall Final Exam Exemptions

Only Certain Class for Fall Exemption

Must have all Fees and Fines Paid

4 absences and at least a 70

No discipline

*All absences count against exemption except school related business (field trips, UIL, etc.)

Tutorials

When: During Lightning Lunch A and B sessions

Advisory is every 1st day of the week during 3rd period to plan your tutorial time and see what classes you have been drafted to.

Students may attend tutorials with any teacher/classroom.

Lightning Lunch Expectations

No More Preordering Lunch

It is imperative that if you are going to an A Session tutorial you go there first and take B lunch and vice versa.

You will not be able to get into the pods once the passing period bell rings

If the teacher is not in their room you are not allowed to be in there.

Lightning Lunch Expectations

Where can you eat lunch: In the cafeteria, any tiled area down Mane Street, and specific teacher classrooms. You may NOT eat on any carpeted area.

Going out to the parking lot or another student's vehicle without permission is prohibited. Students who are caught will receive consequences. Students are NOT allowed to eat in their vehicles.

Tardies

5 tardies = Parent contact and Warning

10 tardies = 2hr D - Hall/Parent contact

15 tardies = ISS/Parent contact

20 or more tardies = additional ISS/Parent
contact/Behavior Contract
