PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATION	No school will make available for use and public access any automatic external defibrillator device (AED) that is not FDA-approved for public access defibrillation.
PROGRAM COORDINATION	<p>The District nursing services coordinator will administer the AED program and will serve as coordinator for the AED program.</p> <p>The coordinator will provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and AED training to campus nurses, and to campus first responders. Certified athletic trainers, and coaches and will provide CPR and AED training within their department. Other certified CPR/AED instructors will assist with training employees throughout the district. The nursing services coordinator will communicate with local emergency service (EMS) providers and will inform all local EMS providers of the existence, location, and type of AED available in the District.</p> <p>The medical director for Ector County ISD will serve as the medical director for the District's AED program within his role of directing health services.</p>
FUNDING	The Board may accept public gifts of AEDs for placement at school campuses. [See CDC] The District may purchase AEDs if identified in the approved budget. [See CE]
TRAINING	The Emergency Operations Planning Team will facilitate CPR/AED training sessions offered to employees. All instructors will be certified and will use either the American Red Cross or the American Heart Association curriculum. Training will be valid for one school year and offered annually. Campus nurses will schedule periodic practice of the skills learned in the training. Athletic trainers will conduct the periodic practice within the Athletics Department.
USE	When an AED is used, the coordinator will promptly notify local EMS providers and will provide a case review to the Superintendent and the Medical Director.
AED MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE	The campus nurse will schedule periodic maintenance and testing of equipment, according to the manufacturer's guidelines. Health Services Department will maintain the maintenance records.
MAINTENANCE	The program coordinator and the athletic director will submit a maintenance request in the annual budget. When an AED is no longer serviceable, the item will be deleted from the campus equipment inventory and forwarded to the central office for disposal. [See CI]
STORAGE	The campus principals and athletic director, in consultation with the program coordinator, will determine the location of each AED.
