Exhibit B—Resolution of the Board Regarding Hazardous Traffic Conditions

WHEREAS, Education Code 42.155(d) allows the Board of Trustees of Ector County Independent School District to obtain supplemental state funding for transporting regular, otherwise ineligible students who live within two miles of their school but who would be subject to hazardous traffic conditions if they walked to school;

WHEREAS, the Texas Education Agency handbook on School Transportation Allotments requires the Board to adopt language providing the definition of hazardous traffic conditions applicable to the District and identifying the specific hazardous areas for which such funding is requested; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges Education Code 42.155(d) provisions, stating that a hazardous condition exists where no walkway is provided and children must walk along or cross a freeway or expressway, an underpass, an overpass or a bridge, an uncontrolled major traffic artery, an industrial or commercial area, or another comparable condition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Ector County Independent School District has determined that a hazardous condition exists because there is no walkway where students must walk along or cross: _____

Exhibit C—Resolution of the Board Regarding Areas with a High Risk of Violence

WHEREAS, Education Code 42.155(d) allows the Board of Trustees of Ector County Independent School District to obtain supplemental state funding for transporting regular, otherwise ineligible students who live within two miles of their school but who would be subject to a high risk of violence if they walked to school; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges Education Code 42.155(d)(1) provisions stating that an area presents a high risk of violence if law enforcement records indicate a high incidence of violent crimes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that after consultation with local law enforcement agencies and review of consolidated supporting documentation to identify walking areas with a high incident of violent crimes, the Board of Trustees of Ector County Independent School District has determined that an area with a high risk of violence does occur in the following areas:

(specific areas as reflected in consolidated law enforcement records that document violent crimes identified by reporting agencies within the relevant jurisdiction; records must be attached).

Exhibit D—School District Certification Supporting Operation of an Out-of-District Transportation System

As authorized by Section 34.007(a)(3) of the Texas Education Code, the Board of Trustees of the Ector County Independent School District may, without entering into an interlocal agreement with other districts, establish and operate an economical public school transportation system outside the District to transport enrolled students who reside outside the District if:

- The Board has a policy that prohibits screening of interdistrict transfer students based on the student's academic performance, disciplinary history, or attendance records; and
- The District certifies that the District complies with Education Code 34.007(a)(3)(B).

I, _____ (*name of superintendent*), Superintendent, hereby attest that the Ector County Independent School District has:

1. An overall performance rating of C or higher under Education Code 39.054 for the preceding school year or the most recent school year in which a performance rating was assigned;
2. An overall accountability score of 70 or higher for the preceding school year or the most recent school year in which a performance rating was assigned as calculated by TEA for determining the District's overall performance rating under Education Code 39.054; and
3. The same or better overall performance rating under Education Code 39.054 for the preceding school year or the most recent school year in which a performance rating was assigned as the school district from which the District will transport students.
