Resources such as online curriculum, educational videos, virtual tutorials, adaptive software, and many other opportunities offer teachers and students a rapidly increasing variety of tools that impact teaching and learning and help to prepare them as future ready learners.

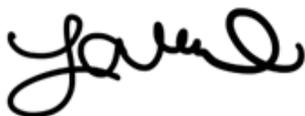
All websites, digital licenses, and technology tools made available to students by Ector County ISD have been vetted by our district's team that supports instruction for quality, appropriateness, online security, and data privacy. The digital resources available to your child will vary based on age and grade level, and the expectations for use of these resources are outlined in the Ector County ISD Student Agreement for Responsible Use of the District's Technology Resources.

Also, the District contracts with online educational services for essential tools and daily efficiencies such as the online grade book and the online lunch account management system. Where personally identifiable student information is implicated, service providers act as District officials and access only the information needed to perform the contracted service. These outside parties are under the District's direct control regarding student data use and maintenance.

Transparency about student engagement with digital tools and how we ensure data privacy and cybersecurity are priorities for Ector County ISD Technology.
