COMMUNICATORS

Because of our small class sizes, emphasis on “living books,” and our belief that narration improves comprehension – our students read, write, and speak every day in class.

UNPLUGGED

Phones are not allowed to be out of a student’s backpack after the school day begins. Our students engage with teachers, academic content, and each other – all day, every day.

HARD WORKING

Our students are required to complete 50 internship hours prior to graduation. Due to our 4-day week, they have Fridays available to work at a job outside of school. Over the years students have worked at companies such as *American Airlines, Atrium Health, Berkshire/Hathaway Realtors, Elevation Church, Gat3 Studios, High Performance Technologies, JenCon Builders, Mecklenburg County District Attorney’s office, and Waxhaw Elementary School* – to name a few.

SERVANT LEADERS

Our students give 60 or more service hours to the community and go on at least two mission trips prior to graduation. They have served annually at more than two-dozen non-profit organizations locally and have been on mission trips internationally in Guatemala, Honduras, Kenya, and Nicaragua.
