UNIT	Learning Objectives / Activities
Introduction & Careers in Healthcare	Students will research and describe careers in healthcare. Activities: Presentations, class discussions, and interviewing professionals
Documentation (SOAP notes)	Students will analyze patient communication for the purpose of documenting.  Activities: Partner and Group work, Interviews
Medical Abbreviations , Acronyms and Symbols	Students will recognize the terminology related to the health science industry  Activities: Position statement review, partner work, documentation follow up
"Do Not use" review	Students will recognize the incorrect use of abbreviations, acronyms, and symbols through review of The Joint Commission's "Do Not Use List" Activities: Real-life scenarios, Training Room assistance
Component Parts of Medical Words	Students will identify and define the component parts of medical words including root, prefix, suffix, and combining vowels  Activities: SOAP note and document practice
