CREDIT BY
EXAMINATION

A student who has received prior instruction in a subject in elementary grades or in an academic course at the secondary level and who has received a grade of at least 60 in the subject or course failed may use a credit by examination to demonstrate mastery of the essential knowledge and skills. A student who has excessive absences may be permitted to earn or regain course credit only on the approval of the attendance committee. Under no circumstances shall credit by examination be used to gain eligibility for participation in extracurricular activities.

PROCEDURE

An eligible student who wishes to take a credit by examination shall submit the following documents to the principal for approval:

1. Application for Credit by Examination [See EEJA (Exhibit)A] for Grades K – 8 or Grades 9 – 12.

These forms shall be sent to the Superintendent's designee. Appropriate tests for grades 1 through 12 shall be purchased by ECISD from Texas Tech University. All tests shall be administered by District personnel.

A grade of 70 or above on the examination shall be the passing standard.

PASSING SCORE

AVERAGING
SEMESTER GRADE

Students who pass the examination with a grade of 70 or above may average that grade with the grade from the appropriate corresponding semester. If that averaged grade is 70 or above, the student may receive the full credit for that course. To be eligible for grade averaging, credit by examination must be completed within the academic school year or summer school following that school year.
