ACCELERATION

A student who wishes to accelerate to the next grade level shall follow the guidelines listed below.

GRADES K-12

Parents of a student in grades K - 12 who wish to accelerate the student shall meet with the principal. The request for acceleration can be made prior to the District registration deadlines listed on the calendar for Credit-by- Examination on the District website.

1. Parents must fill out the "Application for Credit by Examination" [See EEJA(EXHIBIT)A]. The application must be signed by the principal and the form shall be sent to the Superintendent's Designee.

The student shall be tested by District personnel using tests purchased from Texas Tech University.

Initially, the student will be tested in math and language arts. A student who scores 80% on both tests shall then be tested in science and social studies.

Parents of a student who achieves a score of 80% requirements for acceleration and shall be instructed to notify the principal at the campus. A copy of this letter shall also be mailed to the principal. A student who does not score 80% on both the language arts and math tests shall not continue testing. Principals shall be notified that the student has not met the acceleration requirements.
