BALLOT LANGUAGE:

PORTLAND PUBLIC SCHOOLS BOND PROPOSAL

Shall Portland Public Schools, Ionia, Clinton, and Eaton Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Two Million Six Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$2,660,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor for the purpose of remodeling, equipping and re-equipping, and furnishing and refurnishing Oakwood Elementary School and the High School?

Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.

The proposed bond will generate funding for facility improvements through an extension of the current tax rate







High School Floor Plan
