

TITLE V OF PENAL CODE:
OFFENSES AGAINST A PERSON

(REGULATION)

INVESTIGATIONS Building principals or their designees, who have reasonable grounds to believe that a penal code Title 5 felony offense (see FOC EXHIBIT) has occurred in school, on school property, or at a school-sponsored or school-related activity on or off school property, shall notify the District police. In the event police are unavailable, then a local law enforcement agency shall be notified. The principal or designee shall provide for the immediate safety and welfare of any student or person involved but shall otherwise turn any investigation of the criminal offense over to the appropriate law enforcement agency as stated herein. If the allegations involve violation of the District's policies against sexual harassment, then the principal or designee shall thereafter notify the appropriate persons as provided in Board policy also advising those persons as to which law enforcement agency is conducting an investigation of the incident.
