

Standard Attire Regulations

1. Common elements that pertain to standard attire within the same feeder pattern.

A. Pants/Shorts Style

1. Dress pants or dockers style pants, shorts, skirts, capris, skorts and jumpers are acceptable.
2. No cargo style or patched pockets on any garment are allowed.
3. One size larger rule applies.

B. Shirts/Tops

1. Long/short sleeved collared shirts (polo type or oxford style) are acceptable.
2. Must be tucked in during the school day.
3. A long sleeved undershirt is acceptable only under a standard attire shirt in acceptable school colors.
4. One size larger rule applies.

C. Sweaters/Sweatshirts

1. Must be worn over a collared standard attire shirt.
2. One size larger rule applies.
3. No sweatshirts with hoods, zippers or pockets
4. Sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn inside the building as long as they meet the standard attire guidelines and are not tied around the waist.

D. Belts

1. Must be worn at all times if garment has belt loops.
2. Only black or brown leather belts are acceptable unless the belt is provided by the school.

E. Coats/Jackets

1. Coats or jackets must be left in the locker while in the building.

F. Other Provisions

1. Colors of garments are determined by the campus committee that includes parents.
2. Shoes must meet Student Code of Conduct (SCOC) provisions.
3. Logos must be removed from the garment.
4. ID's are required to be worn with a lanyard on campus as part of the standard attire.
5. Colors. No defacing of school ID's (stickers, etc.).
6. Clothing must be worn the way it was designed to be worn.

II. Campus Procedure for Violations:

A. First Offense

1. Student is given opportunity to correct the problem at school.
2. If not corrected, the student will be assigned to In School Suspension (ISS) until the parent or designee brings the acceptable change of clothing to School.

B. Repeated violations will be dealt with as per the Student Code of Conduct.
