#### **NEW TOOLS FOR THE CLASSROOM**

Desert Ridge Junior High has added two new systems for the classroom this year, SmartPass and Attendance Scanners. SmartPass is a digital pass that allows us to track student movement on campus without a paper Students use their I.D.'s in order to generate a pass to go to the restroom, get water, or go to the nurse. The benefit to this system is that we are better able to track the number of students moving about the campus at any given time, as well as long term data regarding which students are moving where, and from what rooms. The Attendance scanners allow teachers to take attendance as students enter the classroom by scanning student I.D.'s. We are hopeful that this addition will help improve our attendance accuracy during the school day.

## Parent/Pick-Up and Drop-Off

Parent Pick up and drop off continues to be a smooth, but busy time. Please be patient as hundreds of students are transitioning to and from campus in about 10-15 minutes.






