## The Assumption of Mary into Heaven

August 15 is the Feast of the Assumption. St. Francis de Sales has a beautiful understanding of Mary's assumption. Mary shared but one heart and one will with her beloved Son. As his heart was pierced on Calvary, so was hers. And when he ascended into glory, her heart accompanied Him there as well.


Yet, in response to the divine will for her, Mary remained here on earth and was completely faithful to whatever God asked of her, as did her Son. Thus, while Mary's heart was in heaven as it were, her feet were firmly planted on earth. She actively participated in the life of the early Church, comforting the first disciples after the death of Jesus and challenging them forth as evangelizers after the gift of the Holy spirit at Pentecost. Mary remained here as the "Mother of the Church," even as her heart was already where her Son was, in glory. Thus, she was able to say, long before St. Paul did, "I live now, not I. Jesus lives in me."

For Francis de Sales, the death of Mary was simply the moment in time when she finally went to where her heart had longed since gone before: she went to be with Jesus in heaven. Her assumption then, is simply an ecstasy, a going out of herself, into God. It is the moment when her body and soul finally and fully catch up with her heart!

The spiritual story of Mary is the story of every Christian. We are often busy about many things, as Martha was in the gospel story of Martha and Mary. We are naturally occupied with raising and caring for our family, and in actively participating in the works of charity and the spiritual and corporal works of

mercy. Our Christian vocation keeps us rooted in the world where we work tirelessly to promote the Gospel principles of peace and justice, while directing creation back to its Creator through responsible stewardship over earth's limited, fragile and increasingly threatened natural resources. But while busy with these many legitimate concerns, the example of Mary keeps us riveted on the Beloved above. We are determined to live here in such a manner that one day, like Mary before us, we too may go to where our heart is already at home: with the Lord!



**Décimo Noveno Domingo en el Tiempo Ordinario**

Las lecturas de hoy nos exhortan a ser siervos fieles de Nuestro Señor. Este es un tema recurrente en los escritos de San Francisco de Sales:

Las Escrituras nos dicen que debemos aferrarnos fuertemente a lo que tenemos. Aun así, nosotros somos como los corales que fácilmente se doblan por el movimiento de las corrientes marinas. Como aún habitamos en el mar de este mundo, somos propensos a doblarnos por lado y lado – de un lado por el amor divino, y del otro lado cediendo ante la tentación que representan los Bienes que, aunque vacíos, aparentan ser benéficos.

Estos supuestos Bienes son como zorros que se encargan de destruir Nuestro viñedo; mientras que el amor divino nos urge a que hagamos de Nuestro corazón un lugar fértil, por medio de las buenas obras. Por consiguiente, debemos emplear nuestra mente en la práctica del amor Sagrado, para que esos supuestos Bienes no ejerzan su influencia sobre nosotros.
