2021 Fire Island Basketball Tournament Health & Safety Protocols

** The tournament will always abide by all active CDC/DOE guidelines

- Our 2021 tournament will occur on 8/20, 8/21, 8/22, 8/27, 8/28, 8/29, 9/3, 9/4 & 9/5
 - o Fridays are 4-9pm, Saturday and Sundays are 9-6pm
- All players MUST be vaccinated to sign up, with proof provided
- All spectators ages 16 and over (eligible for vaccine) will require proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test
- The playoffs and championship game which always occur over Labor Day weekend are the only games we have any spectators at. For those games we will set a maximum capacity number of 100 which will allow all spectators to spread out.
- One entrance will be closed, allowing for a volunteer to check for vaccine and testing requirements
- Entrances will be staffed with a volunteer who will be administering temperature checks at all time
- All chairs, tables, wires, and equipment will be kept outdoors – not in the school – and cleaned daily
- Hand sanitizer will be provided to all players and spectators
- Fans within separate families will be asked to abide by social distancing guidelines
- The entire 2021 tournament will be played OUTDOORS ONLY
- While the tournament would like access to the bathroom facilities – which would be staffed for temperate and vaccine/test checks – we do not want this to be an impediment to approval
- One of the 4 Assistant commissioners will be assigned to each day of our 3 weekend long tournament to ensure all the above guidelines are followed. Those include Chris Brahe, Matt Covrigaru, Josh Schure and Dina Mandelbaum
