Student Services:

- **Ms. Cowsette (school social worker):** Works with students who require additional services and need help with larger situations; offers lunch-bunch, emotional regulation and coping skills; assists homeless and foster care students; does behavior consultations.
- **Ms. Schrodel (school counselor):** Provides lessons for students (K-5); discusses future plans with career bingo and career interest survey; provides social/emotional learning; discusses friendships and safe hands/safe words.
- Both work on a newsletter. Next edition will go out in March. Offered to partner with HSA.

3-on-3 Basketball Tournament:

- **Mr. Dunn:** Free event on March 18th offering two tournaments in one night (girls v. girls; boys v. boys) for 4th and 5th grade students. Everyone who is interested gets to play.
