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ENGAGEMENT OPPORTUNITIES

CAREER PREPARATION

Career Preparation activities provide participants with extended opportunities to deepen their understanding of a field, while also gaining employability skills and some entry-level technical knowledge. Common engagements include:

- Workplace Challenge/Skills Demo
- Service/Volunteer Learning
- Mock Interviews and Resume Workshops
- Industry Based Certification Support

CAREER EXPLORATION

Career Exploration activities at this stage of the continuum are typically introductory and short-term. They offer participants an opportunity to learn about various industries and employers, including those that may be unfamiliar. Common engagements include:

- · Worksite Tours
- Job Shadowing
- Career Panels/Forums
- Guest Speaker

CAREER TRAINING

Career training activities involve allowing participants to acquire specific skills in a particular industry or occupation, often in conjunction with classroom or lab instructions. Can include paid opportunities. Common engagements include:

- On-the-Job Training
- Internships
- Transitional Jobs
- Workplace Challenges
- Skills Demonstrations
