TAX CREDIT PROGRAM

The **Georgia GOAL Scholarship Program** allows individuals and corporations to redirect a portion of their state income tax to the HIES financial aid program. On average, our community contributes almost **\$1M annually!**

The program strengthens the Holy Innocents' financial aid budget each year to ensure aid is available to outstanding students with financial need.



PARENT GROUPS
