Mission Statement

Annual Title I Meeting

Parents are invited to attend this meeting at the beginning of the school year to learn more about our schoolwide Title I Program and requirements of Title I. Shared Decision-Making

Families will be invited to many meetings and events throughout the year to receive academic information, reports, and provide input on ways the school, families and students can share responsibility for student success. We hope you will join us for School Advisory Council (SAC) meetings, (1st Tuesday of each month at 6pm), teacher-parent conferences, Title I meetings, parent trainings, and school events.

Parent and Family Engagement Trainings

Based on input from our families and staff last year, we will provide the following activities to assist families in understanding their children's academic achievement and support learning at home:

- **STEM Night** - We will partner with the Cox Science Center to offer a Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) Night to increase parents and students' engagement and understanding of science concepts. This event is scheduled for November.
- **Breakfast & Books with a Role Model**- Students and their role model will read and discuss books together over breakfast. Research supports the positive impact a male role model has on student achievement. Adults will learn strategies for reading to and with their child as well as how to have conversations before, during and after reading. This event is scheduled for January.
- **All Pro Dads**, a national educational and charitable organization, will begin a DDE Chapter. Once a month, dads can come to DDE to engage in meaningful conversations and activities with their child centered on character development. These events will be ongoing.



School-Home Communication
