Dear Longhorn Family,

As we begin the 2025–26 school year, many of our students have experienced challenges with their initial schedules. I want to take a moment to clarify the scheduling process at the high school and address any misconceptions.

Several factors impact student schedules, the largest being the Rural Schools Innovations Zone (RSIZ), also known as “the Zone.” Students travel to Freer, Premont, Falfurrias, Kingsville, and Benavides for Zone courses. These courses follow specific schedules:

- Some meet on Monday/Wednesday/Every Other Friday (M/W/EOF)
- Others meet on Tuesday/Thursday/Every Other Friday (T/Th/EOF)

When students are not traveling to their Zone campus, they will be assigned to a Success Lab at Agua Dulce. For example, M/W/EOF travelers are in Success Lab on T/Th, and vice versa. This time is dedicated to coursework assigned by their Zone instructors.

Additionally, all “travelling students” must take their required graduation coursework in the afternoons. To further complicate scheduling, some students are also enrolled in dual credit classes, which follow the college calendar rather than our high school calendar.

Because of these factors, we anticipate needing through Friday to finalize all schedule changes. Our counselors began working with seniors first and are moving grade by grade down to the 6th grade.

A few important notes:

- If your student’s schedule is still incorrect after Friday, please email me at barry.truelove@adisd.net.
- There is no 6th grade art class this year. Instead, 6th graders will be scheduled for Music, which is not band but does fulfill the Fine Arts requirement.
- Not all schedule change requests can be accommodated. Counselors must ensure students remain on the correct graduation pathway and meet all requirements for certifications and endorsements.

We appreciate your patience as we work through this complex process. Our priority is to ensure that every student has a schedule that sets them up for academic success and timely graduation.
