## FALL TESTING

In the spring of 2018, the Nebraska Legislature passed into law the Nebraska Reading Improvement Act (section 79-2601-79-2607). The purpose of this act is to position all students for success in their educational journey by focusing on the development of early reading skills.

## This act requires schools to:

- \*Assess students in kindergarten through third grade three times each year with a state-approved universal screening assessment.
  - \*Notify families if their child scores below the required achievement threshold set by the state on the assessment.
- \*Develop an Individual Reading Improvement Plan (IRIP) for students who score below the threshold that informs families what the school is going to do to help the student improve his/her early reading skills.

The universal screener we use at Boone Central Elementary with students in Kindergarten through fourth grade is FastBridge for Reading and Math. These students also complete the MAP Growth Reading and Math tests.

# **NURSE'S CORNER**



Can you believe we already need to think about getting back to school? Being at school everyday and on time is so important! It may not seem like a big deal to miss a couple of days a month or show up late once a week, but the research is black and white. The more days students are gone the more that their academics will struggle. Also, by 6th grade those students who are missing 2 or more days a month have a higher chance of not graduating high school. There are multiple reasons a student may be gone or late to school, but as parents we need to do our part to encourage them to be there as often and on time everyday!

#### Here's some tips to get off on a good foot when coming back to school:

-Set a strict bedtime and wake up time.

-Do as much as you can the night before to make your mornings easier.

-Don't let your child stay home if you are not sure they are truly sick. Anxiety can also mimic those physical illnesses.

-If your child seems continuously battling with you to not want to go to school, let us know! It takes a village and we are willing to help you!

-Avoid appointments and vacations during the school day as much as possible, take advantage of those late Wednesdays or days off.

-If your child does have a chronic or acute illness let me know and let's find ways to make things more comfortable for them at school! Sometimes just knowing they will be cared for can help!


