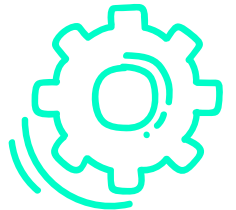

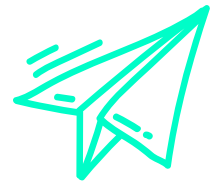

# Behavior-Cell Phone Policy

 Cell phone and Electronic Devices Policy 	
<p><b>Policy</b></p> <p>All cell phones and electronic devices will be placed in backpack from the time students enter school to the time students leave school.</p> <p><b>Purpose</b></p> <p>To provide a school culture without the distraction cell phones and electronic devices on campus.</p>	<p><b>Consequences</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. First offense: Phone goes to the office and phone dialer home</li><li>2. Second offense: Parent picks up device</li><li>3. Third offense: Wednesday School and Parent picks up device</li><li>4. Fourth offense: Saturday School and Parent picks up device</li><li>5. Fifth offense: No cellphone, must be checked in before school</li></ol>
<p><b>Motto</b></p> <p>Cell phones should not replace Chromebooks.</p>	

# Electronic Devices

- All **wireless** AirPods/Bluetooth electronic devices are NOT allowed. Including electronic watches (ex. Apple watch) and cameras.
- **WIRED** earbuds or **WIRED** headset may be used only connected to your Chromebook at lunch.

# Bathroom Policy

- Use the restroom; before school, passing period, lunch, and after school.
- If you need to go to the restroom during class you will need to complete a MINGA pass.

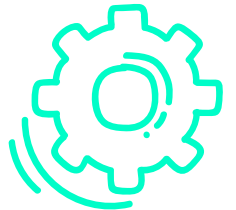
**\*\*\*Avoid restroom use during 5th\*\*\***

# Behavior- Dress Code

## Students Cannot Wear:

- Clothing or accessories with images or language that:
  - Is violent
  - Depicts drugs or alcohol (or any illegal item or activity) or their use
  - Include hate speech, profanity, or pornography (including symbols)
  - Is likely to create a hostile or intimidating environment based on any protected class
- Undergarments, sheer materials and swimwear of similar design worn as outerwear.
- Headwear or clothing, that obscures the face and/or head that prevents identification (except as a religious observance or health/safety-related guidelines, including health and safety facial coverings)
- All tops must have at least 1 strap.
- No hats worn indoors

- On the way to school

- “No pantsing”= Sexual Harassment
  - ALWAYS keep your hands and feet to yourself.

# Behavior- Crosswalk
