ONLINE PIFE COURSE OFFERINGS FOR NV TEACHER LICENSING

General PIFE Course Description

Completion of one of these three online courses will allow educators, nurses, counselors, and administrators to remove their Parental Involvement and Family Engagement (PIFE) provision for a NV teaching license. Each course is 3 credits and are offered during the fall and spring semesters (see schedule on the right) with select courses offered during the summer semester. EDUC 323 is designed for elementary and secondary teachers, EDSP 434 is for special education teachers, and HDFS 202 is for Pre-K to 2nd grade teachers.
