1 Register for I-Apply

3 Application Materials

Prospective students who do not attend diocesan schools must submit a non-diocesan application form on I-Apply, our digital admissions portal. I-Apply application materials include:

- Application Form*
- Teacher Recommendation*
- Transcript (if available)
- Report Card (8th Grade - Quarter 1 or Semester 1)*
- Report Card (7th Grade)*
- Standardized Testing (MAP, OST, or similar scores)*
- Copy of birth certificate*
- HSPT Scores*: All HSPT scores from tests taken at Saint Ignatius are already on file, so you do not need to re-submit those scores. However, you are welcome to upload any additional HSPT test scores taken at other schools to your I-Apply account.
