School is back in session!! And so are school zone speed limits!

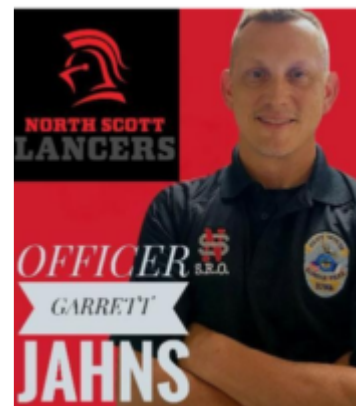
Remember: A,B,C, it's as easy as 1,2,3

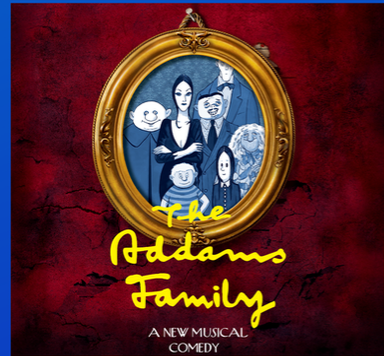

## Schedules

Students will be able to see their schedules on Monday, 8/11. Student schedules will not be printed out. You can find your schedule on Infinite Campus. Schedule change requests will only be considered for the following reasons:

- Academic misplacement: Student is placed in the wrong level of class, has failed a class or is placed in a class without meeting the pre-requisite
- Missing an academic class or graduation requirement
- The course was already completed
- Two or more courses are scheduled during the same block and a conflict exists
- Inappropriate course load

## Drivers Education Registration Information

The [AEA Driver Education Program](#) follows the state-approved driver education guidelines. We provide 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction. Included in the classroom component, students complete four hours of substance abuse education, 20 minutes on railroad crossing, information on organ donation, and instruction providing awareness about sharing the road with bicycles and motorcycles.

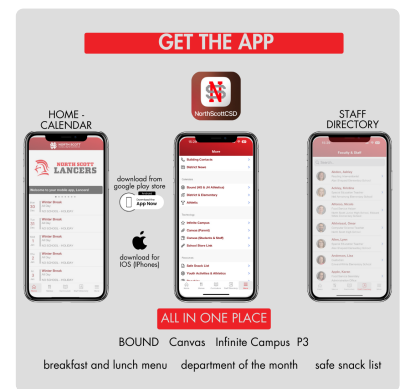

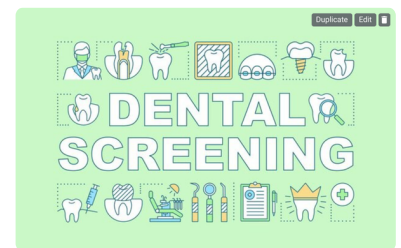
