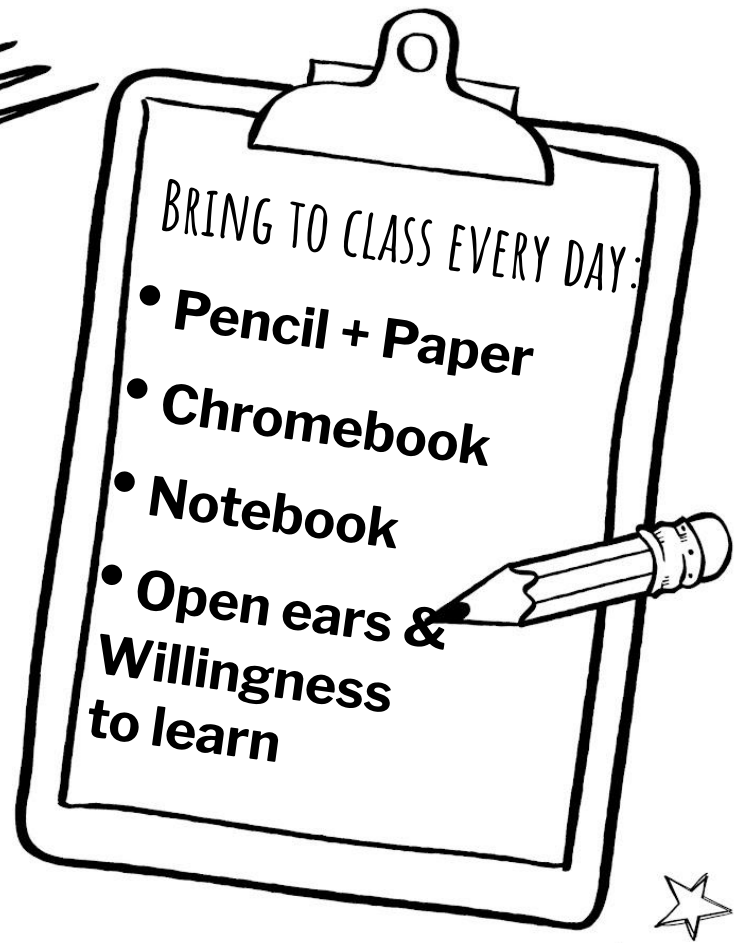

# POLICIES & PROCEDURES

## ABSENCE POLICY

Your class will spend over an hour each day acquiring language & you may have to spend a similar amount of time at home to make up what you have missed. This will be difficult, so try to be here if you can! It is **your responsibility** to obtain any missed assignments. I will post topics of lessons on Google Classroom for you to check before returning. Missed worksheets, etc. can be obtained from the teacher whenever you return to school. **\*Keep in mind that you will have as many days to make-up missing assignments as days missed.** See your CHS handbook/Student Code of Conduct for more explanations on absences

## TARDY POLICY

When the tardy bell rings, the classroom door will be locked and I will begin teaching. If you are tardy to 1<sup>st</sup> block, you must go to the office and get a tardy slip. No notes from other teachers, etc. will be accepted to enter the class. **I will be deducting 3 points from your participation grade for each unexcused tardy.** See your CHS handbook/Student Code of Conduct for more explanations on absences. **\*Being more than 5 minutes late is considered to be skipping class. Administration will be notified of the student's action and he/she will be asked to go to the office.**

## SUPPLIES

Supplies are in the back of the room. Here you can find anything you may need for class: pencil/pens, paper, hole punch, stapler, tissues, hand sanitizer, etc.

**\*Keep in mind that bringing your chromebook, notebook, paper and pencils to class is always required and YOUR responsibility.**

## SMARTPASS

CHS uses an electronic hall pass system called Smartpass. To leave class, you will first need to ask permission and then create a hall pass via Smartpass. This is required and will be monitored when out of the classroom during class times. Any student in the hallway during class time must have a hall pass...one hall-pass per student.

## CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS:

- Speak Spanish as much as possible!
- Be supportive and encourage others. You can help each other a lot!
- Come to class every day prepared to work & Complete assignments on time.
- Participate actively in class: be engaged, sit up, pay attention, watch what is going on, ask questions when you don't understand, volunteer.
- Practice until you understand and master each new concept or word.
- Spend **at least** 15 minutes outside of class looking over stories, vocabulary lists, etc.

## CLASSROOM RULES:

**--Be Kind** – Students will exhibit courtesy and respect toward all other students at all times. Hateful comments concerning race, gender, sexuality, political views, appearance, or of any other type will not be tolerated; this applies to serious as well as “joking” comments.

**--Be Attentive** – Listen to instructions the first time they are given.

**--No Sleeping** – You will not be granted the opportunity to be disrespectful and sleep during class.

**--Be on Time** – Being late to class is very disruptive. Be in class on time and in your seat when the bell rings.

**--UnPlug** – Absolutely no cell phone (or technology of any kind) use will be allowed in the classroom per state law.

## USING THE BATHROOM

You have 6 minutes in between classes to use the bathroom; therefore the bathroom may only be used in emergencies. However, you must ask to go to the bathroom in Spanish: **¿Puedo ir al baño, por favor?**

Also, you have to use Smartpass to create a hall pass when leaving the classroom.

## EXTRA CREDIT

The only extra credit that will be given in class is before and after certain tests in the form of flash cards/test corrections and by going to see afterschool movies offered through Cinelit with Mrs. Buis in the LEAPs program.
