


GRADUATION DECISION-MAKING TOOL


To assist Individualized Education Program (IEP) Teams determine if a student with an IEP has met graduation requirements following a typical pathway and when the student must exit secondary school.

Directions: IEP Teams should use this Tool:

- at least annually when the student has turned 14;
- whenever the IEP Team determines data supports a need; and
- when the student meets Ohio graduation requirements and/or reaches his or her 22nd birthday.


If 2 or more Standard Deviations away then the Student will be exempted 2nd semester of Senior Year (April)




