DROP OFF AND PICK UP

All parents drop off in the parking lot on Spring Valley Rd (7:00am)

- 6th grade - drop off at door A2
- 7th and 8th - drop off at main entrance
- Please do not drop off on Revere Rd
- Please do not drop off at the stadium

All students picked up on Spring Valley Rd (2:37pm)

- Please pick up from the main office doors to door A2



BUS RIDERS

All students are dropped off in the stadium parking lot

- Students enter door C3 and go to designated areas
