Welcome to District 63!

Please review the following health requirements for school enrollment. Failure to comply by the first day of school will result in school exclusion until the required forms are submitted.

Physical Examination Form and Immunization Record: Students entering preschool, kindergarten, sixth grade, or who are new to District 63, must submit a current physical and immunization record by the first day of school. Proof of the following vaccines are required:

Vaccine	Preschool Requirement	Kindergarten-5th Grade Requirement	6th-8th Grade Requirement
Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus (DTP or DTaP)	4 doses of DTP/DTaP at the recommended intervals	4 doses of DTP/DTaP at the recommended intervals with the last dose received after turning 4 years old	3 or more doses of DTP, DTaP, DT, or Td with the last dose received after turning 4 years old One dose of Tdap after turning 11 years old
Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib)	Proof of immunization series that complies with the ACIP recommendation	No requirement	
Hepatitis B	3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine at the recommended intervals		
Invasive Pneumococcal Disease (PCV)	Proof of immunization series that complies with the ACIP recommendation	No requirement	
Polio (IPV)	3 doses of IPV at the recommended intervals	4 doses of IPV at the recommended intervals, with the last dose received after turning 4 years old	
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	One dose after turning 1 year old	2 doses of MMR vaccine, with the first dose after turning 1 year old	
Varicella	One dose after turning 1 year old	2 doses of Varicella vaccine, with the first dose after turning 1 year old	
Meningococcal Disease (MCV4) (MenACWY)	No requirement		One dose of MCV4 after turning 11 years old

Eye Examination: Students entering kindergarten or enrolling in an Illinois school for the first time must present proof of an eye examination by a licensed optometrist before October 15 of the school year.

Dental Examination: Students entering kindergarten, second grade, and sixth grade must present proof of dental examination by a licensed dentist before May 15 of the school year.
