# Spectator Expectations

- Students are allowed to enter the gymnasium at 3:45 pm.
- Students can use their phones but not record video or take photos - same expectations as lunchtime use.
- Food and drink are to be consumed in the lobby (not in the gym).
- Students should cheer in a positive and genuine manner at appropriate times.
  - Positive comments directed towards all athletes.
  - Remember it takes courage to perform in front of large crowds.
- Students are expected to be *silent* during free throws and serves.
- Students should refrain from interacting with athletes, coaches, referees, and the opposite team's crowd during events.

# Spectator Expectations

- Students are only allowed in the gym, lobby and lobby bathrooms.
  - Students should not go in the cafeteria, locker rooms, or hallways.
- Students must be picked up by their parents/guardians or walk home no later than 15 minutes after the game ends.




# Things to Remember

- Spectators who need constant reminders from chaperones to follow expectations will be asked to leave.
- If a spectator is consistently demonstrating unsportsmanlike or disrespectful behavior at multiple games, then he or she may be asked not to attend games in the future.

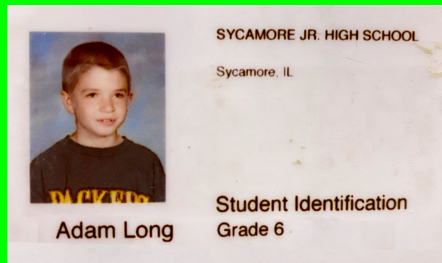
