DRESS & UNIFORM POLICY**

All Bachrodt Students are required to wear school uniforms.

The Bachrodt School Community believes that school uniforms create a safer and more orderly environment, an environment that fosters a sense of belonging, and that instills high standards of academic performance. Please help the school to maintain an appropriate school climate by making sure that your child is in uniform each and every day.

Allowed: Only items described will be allowed. Acceptable colors are listed for each item.	Not Allowed: Items described below are not allowed.
Shirts and Blouses	
Solid Navy Blue, Light Blue or White (Must be tucked in at all times must have a collar)

Solid Navy Blue or Khaki (Must be worn at the waist)

Shoes (Must be fully enclosed)	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes with wheels (Heelys) • Sandals, flip-flops, open-toed shoes, CROCS or CROC style shoes, slippers, or heels
Accessories	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Caps or hats • Gloves, beanies, scarves--may be worn outdoors on cold days • Sports logos on clothing items • Make up, spray-on hair dye, press-on nails

College Spirit Wednesdays: Wednesdays are College Spirit Days. Students may wear a college or university t-shirt/polo shirt/sweatshirt. ****Wednesday is the only day when these shirts may be worn****

Fridays: Students may earn a Free Dress Pass on Fridays. They must Be Safe, Responsible, and Respectful all week in order to earn a Free Dress Pass. A Free Dress Pass will be sent home in our Thursday Folder if it was earned. The last Friday of each month will be a Spirit Day. Spirit Day themes will be shared with families.

IMPORTANT: Parents will receive a reminder from teachers for the first few times a student comes to school out of uniform and a uniform may be loaned to the student for the day. If students continue to come to school out of uniform, parents may be asked to bring required clothing to school for the student. A parent conference with the principal may be necessary if students continue to come to school out of uniform. Please support our school uniform policy.
