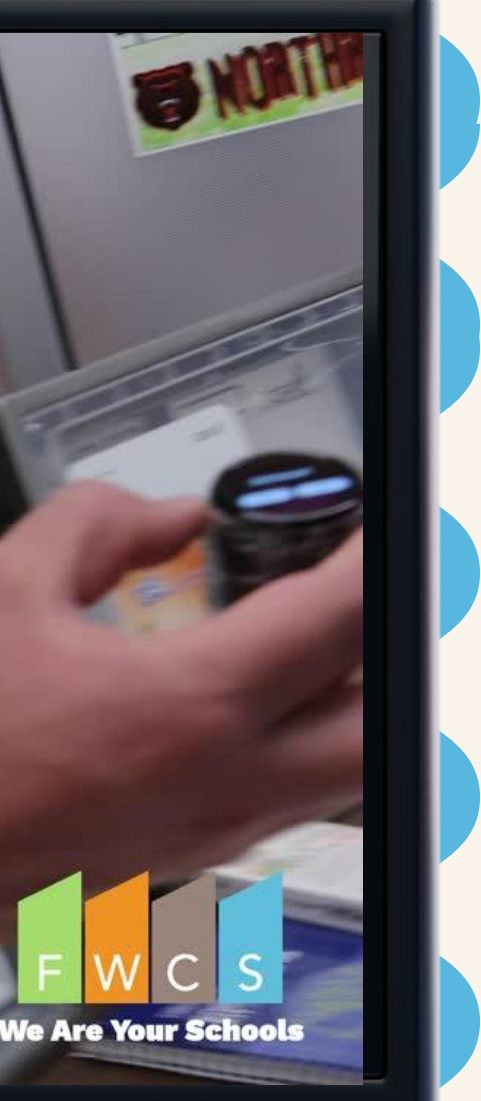

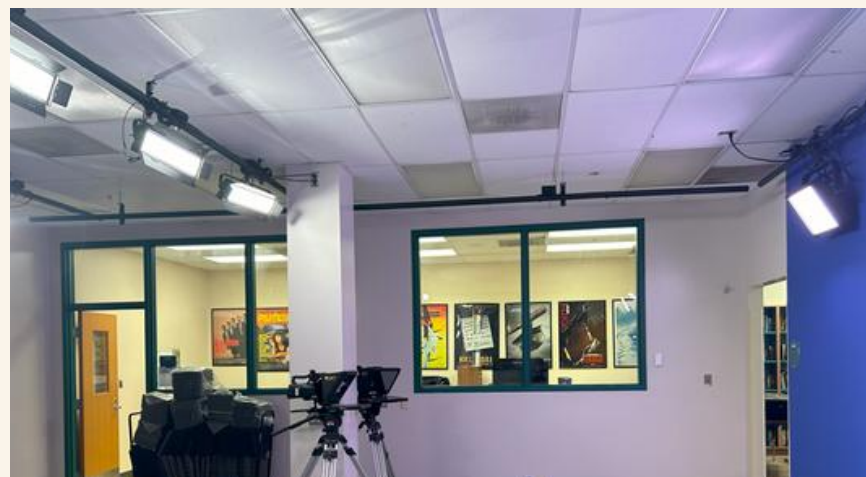
# Major Instructional Projects

**Time and Attendance** - How our hourly employees clock in/out

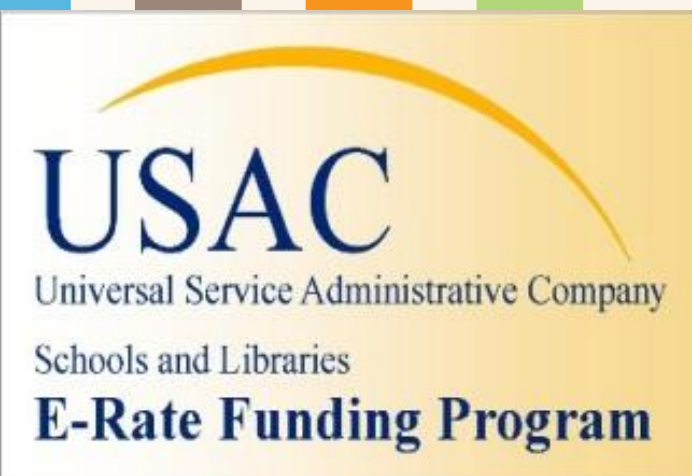
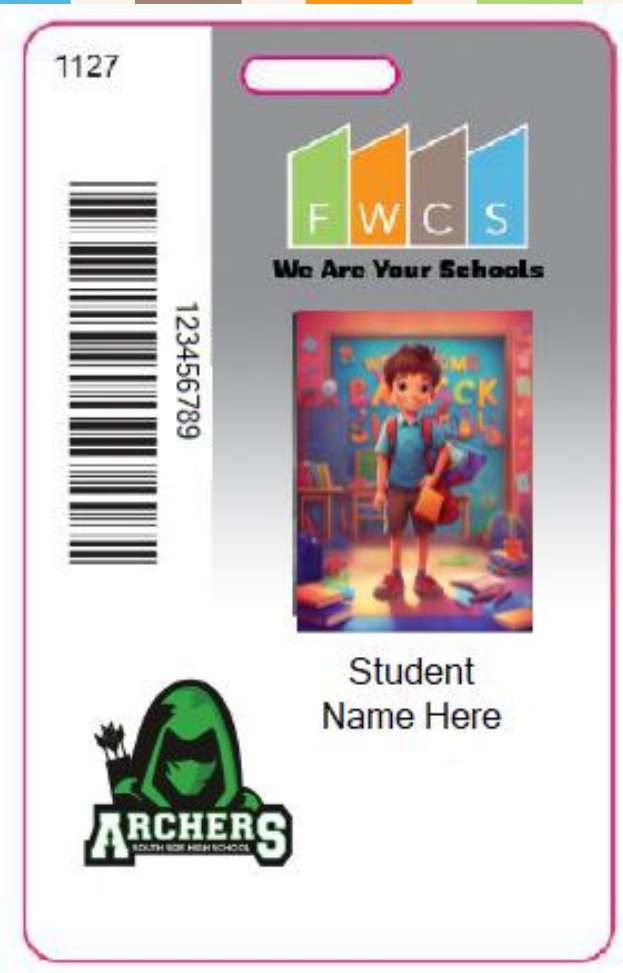
**Student ID Badges** - Buses, Sporting events, Lunch lines, Media Center, ACPL
