

UNION STADIUM SPECTATOR POLICIES

Bags, Backpacks, & Other Outside Items - Guests may carry one clear bag that does not exceed 14"x14"x6" in size OR a small non-clear clutch/purse/wallet that does not exceed 6.5"x4.5" in size. Exceptions will be made for medically necessary items or single compartment diaper bags (child must be present). No backpacks please.

Note: The Mead School District recommends that fans only bring what is absolutely necessary with them to Union Stadium - phone, wallet, money, credit cards, car keys. Please leave all unnecessary items at home or in your vehicle. Backpacks and bags may not be stored at the gates or outside of the venue. Any unattended bags will be confiscated and removed immediately. The Mead School District is not responsible for the care or security of any items left unattended.

Re-Entry to Union Stadium is not allowed

Balls, scooters, bikes, skateboards, etc. are not permitted inside Union Stadium - Fans will not be allowed to throw balls within Union Stadium.

Pets - No pets/animals will be allowed in the stadium or in the surrounding areas, except for service animals with appropriate documentation.

Banners and Poles - Banners may NOT be hung and poles may NOT be brought into Union Stadium unless approved by Mead and/or Mt. Spokane High School Athletic Administration. These can be a nuisance to other fans by obstructing their view of the game and can create safety concerns for those in the area.

Beverage Policy - NO outside food or drink is permitted inside Union Stadium. The possession or consumption of alcohol in areas of Union Stadium and on any Mead School District property is prohibited. Stadium personnel and law enforcement agencies will enforce this policy. Persons who are intoxicated or who are in possession of alcohol are subject to removal from the stadium.

Cameras & Photography - Cameras are permitted in Union Stadium for both fans and members of the news media. All photos taken in Union Stadium must be for editorial or personal use only and may not be used for advertising, promotions or other trade purposes, or any other commercial or promotional endeavor, without the written permission of the Mead School District. Video cameras are not permitted in Union Stadium except for the working news media.

Smoking & Tobacco Use - Smoking and the use of all tobacco products on any Mead School District campus or venue is prohibited. This prohibition applies to all individuals while on any Mead campus, including faculty, staff, students, administrators, contractors, and visitors. Cigarettes, e-cigarettes, cigars, smokeless tobacco, snuff, pipes, and chewing tobacco are not permitted.

Thrown Objects - The throwing of objects from the stands is strictly prohibited and is cause for immediate ejection.
