E	Evaluate and eliminate What steps do I take? What information don't I need?
S	Show your work and check Does my answer make sense? How can I double check?

Ace It

For constructed response questions remember ACES



A - answer the question OR restate the prompt
(1 specific, straightforward sentence)

C - cite evidence from the text
(depending on the examples needed, probably
1 to 2 sentences per prompt)

E - explain your examples in detail
(2 to 3 sentences)

S - sum it up (1 to 2 sentences to conclude)

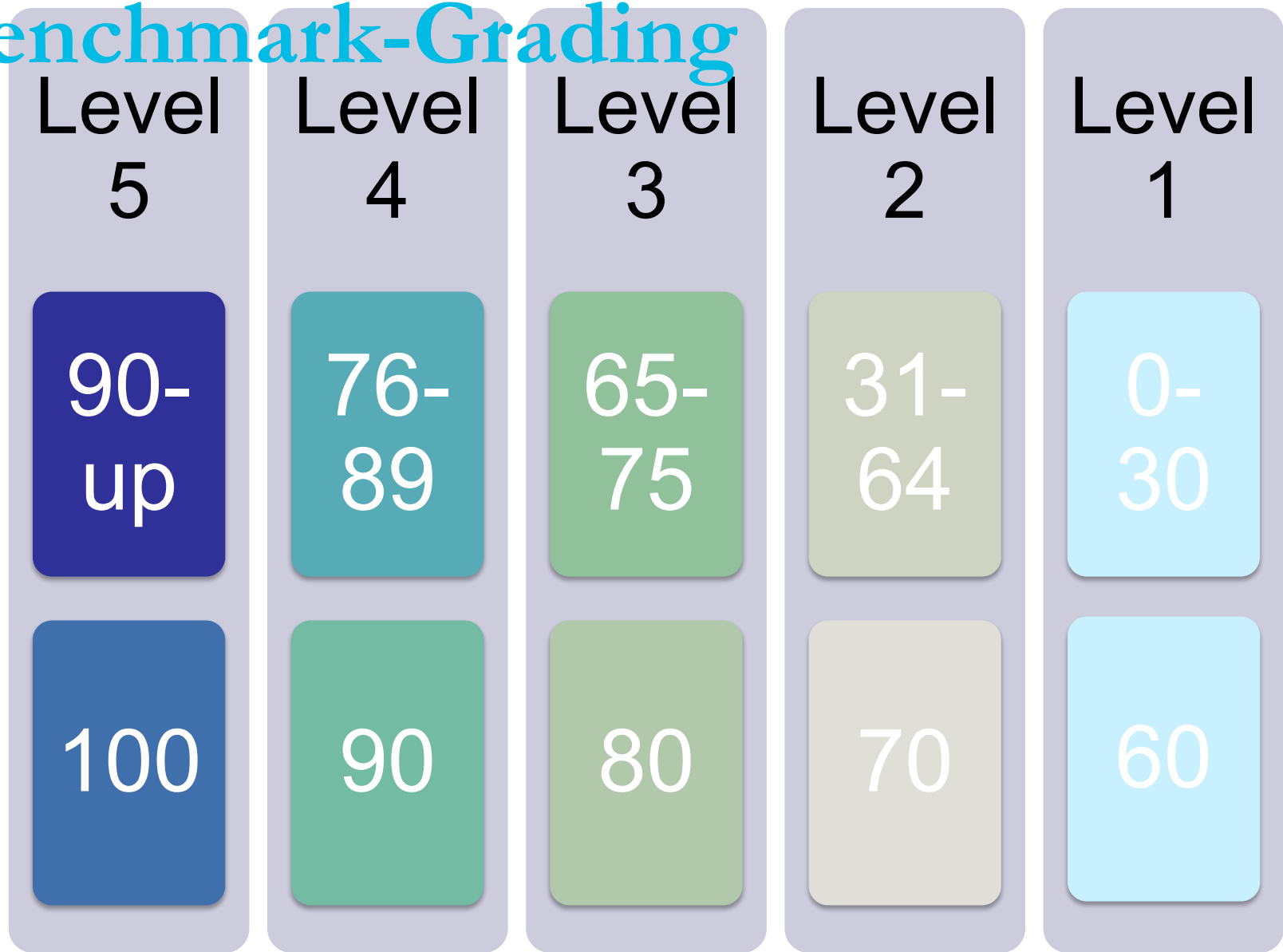
