SUBJECT: **11TH DAY ENROLLMENT COUNT SY2025-26 (FY2026)**

The first official enrollment count of the 2025-26 school year was tabulated on Monday, August 25, 2025. The 11th Day Count is used primarily for school staffing purposes. The October benchmark enrollment count will provide more stabilized enrollment data for planning and enrollment projection purposes.

ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

Total PreK-12 enrollment for traditional district operated schools decreased by 5,701 students from last year’s 11th day enrollment. For all district schools, 11th day PreK-12 enrollment decreased by 6,086 students. **Total SY2025-26 11th day PreK-12 enrollment was 184,976 students;** pre-kindergarten enrollment was 3,662 students. Table 1 summarizes the enrollment data.
