

# Student Rider Policies

To ensure a safe and successful transportation experience for all, please review the following policies with your student.

---

## General Bus Rules

- **Behavior:** The school bus is an extension of the school experience, and expectations for student behavior on the bus are the same as those in the classroom. Any failure to follow these rules will be reported to the appropriate Dean of Students.
  - **Prohibited Items:** For safety, students may not bring food, drink, pets, sharp objects, or toys on the bus. Ice skates must have protective guards.
  - **Aisle Clearance:** All riders must keep the main aisle clear as required by state regulations.

## Bus Schedule and Procedures

- **Be on Time:** Students should be ready at their stop 3-5 minutes before the scheduled time listed in the Transportation Schedule Email. The bus will depart promptly and will not wait for late students. If your student misses the bus, please contact the Transportation Office to arrange an alternative pick-up.
  - **Afternoon & Activity Buses:** Afternoon buses load behind the school and leave promptly at 3:30 PM. Activity buses, available for students in grades 5-12, load in front of the fieldhouse and leave at 5:45 PM.

## Parent & Student Communication

- **Morning Changes:** Please notify the Transportation Office if your student will not be riding the morning bus before 6:30 AM.
- **Afternoon Changes:** Please notify the Transportation Office of any afternoon transportation changes by 1:00 PM.
- **Lower School Students (Grades P-3):** A parent, guardian, or designated person must be visible at the drop-off location for the student to be released from the bus. A designated person must be **5th grade or older** and must be registered with the Transportation Office. If no one is at the stop, the student will be returned to Breck Extended Day.
