

Transportation

Welcome to Corcoran Joint Unified School District. This Brochure was created to provide you with important information regarding your child's transportation.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Parents are legally responsible for their child's transportation to and from school.

Bus transportation is a privilege, which is provided by the district to assist parents in meeting their responsibilities.

Home-School Transportation

The following students are entitled to district transportation to and from school using designated pickup points:

- A. Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade students living beyond 3/4th of a mile from the nearest school.
- B. 4th-12th graders who live beyond 2 miles from the nearest school.

Note: Distances are determined by using the shortest surface street routes to the nearest school. The school district will use official district equipment to determine accuracy of established distance between home and school.

School-to-School Shuttle:

The following students are entitled to shuttle bus service between schools:

Any students who lives inside the specified limits of his/her school will be eligible for shuttle services.

Shuttle service will be provided for the students between the school nearest his/her home to the school he/she will attend.

Bus Rules

1. Observe the same conduct as in the classroom.
2. Be courteous, use no profane language.
3. Do not eat or drink on the bus.
4. Keep the bus clean.
5. Cooperate with the bus driver
6. Alcohol and smoking are strictly forbidden.
7. Do not be destructive.
8. Stay in your seat.
9. Keep your head, hands, and feet inside the bus.
10. Do not throw anything inside or outside the bus.
11. No animals allowed on the bus.
12. No loud talking, yelling, or singing.
13. No weapons of any kind.
14. Students shall obey instructions from the Bus Driver during red light crossovers.
15. Students must stand at least 6 feet away from designated parking while the bus is in motion.
16. Students shall conduct themselves in an orderly and safe manner, obeying all rules of traffic while journeying to and from designated school bus route stops.

Failure to observe above rules may result in a referral to the principal and possible loss of bus privileges.

NOTE: Bus delays are for out of town stops only.
In-town and shuttle buses will run at the regular time.

Discipline Bus Referrals

1st Referral from the Driver:

→ Warning/Conference with parent and site principal.

2nd Referral from the Driver:

→ 1 Day suspension from the bus.

3rd Referral from the Driver:

→ 1 Week suspension from the bus.

4th Referral from the Driver:

→ Can not ride the bus for the rest of the school year.
