Married-Pregnant-Parenting Students BP/AR Policy 5146

Reasonable modifications accommodations may include, but are not limited to:

1. Breaks during class to express milk, breastfeed, or attend to health needs associated with pregnancy or related conditions, including eating, drinking or using the restroom
2. Intermittent absences to attend medical appointments
3. Access to online or homebound education
4. Changes in schedule or course sequence
5. Extensions of time for coursework and rescheduling of tests and examinations
6. Allowing a student to sit and stand, or carry or keep water nearby
7. Counseling
8. Changes in physical space or supplies, such as access to a larger desk or a footrest
9. Elevator access
10. Any other change to policies, practices, or procedures

A student who is pregnant or who has a related condition shall have access to any services available to other students with temporary medical conditions.

1. Access to a private and secure room other than a restroom, that is clean, shielded from view, and free from intrusion by others to express milk or breastfeed and infant child
2. Permission to bring onto a school campus a breast pump and any other equipment used to express breast milk
3. Access to a power source for a breast pump or any other equipment used to express breast milk
4. Access to a place to store expressed breast milk safely
5. A reasonable amount of time to accommodate the students need to express breast milk or breast-feed an infant child
