

EXIT GUIDELINES FOR HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT COURSES TAKEN IN JUNIOR HIGH

At-A-Glance



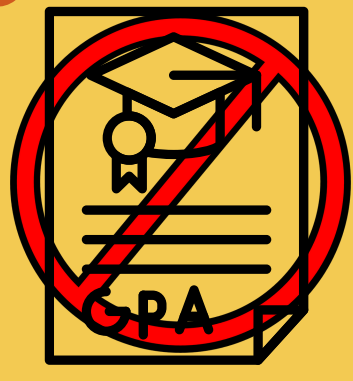
Teachers should make a reasonable effort to contact the parents of struggling students and work collaboratively to support the student's academic progress through communication and proactive support strategies.



01

1st 6 weeks

- **CAMPUS DEADLINE:** students may request to drop their High School credit course
- Any student with a failing grade at the end of the 1st 6 weeks will be removed from the HS credit course and the grade will not be recorded on their academic transcript



02

2nd 6 weeks

- Any student with a failing grade at the end of the 2nd 6 weeks will be removed from the HS credit course and the grade will not be recorded on their academic transcript
- After the 2nd 6 weeks no course changes will be made



Teachers will work with students who are struggling academically or failing. Counselors are available to provide additional guidance and resources to help address academic challenges.

03

End of 1st semester

- Students who earn a failing grade at the end of the 1st semester will have the grade recorded on their academic transcript and be removed from the course.



04

2nd Semester

- No students will be removed from a high school credit course
- Students will remain in their HS credit course until the end of the school year and the grade they earn will be recorded on their academic transcript

Considerations

- The Gifted and Talented Reassessment and Exit Policy will be followed for identified GT math students enrolled in Algebra 1 GT
- Eligible GT students who do not enroll in Algebra I/GT in 8th grade will be exited from the GT Math program
