SOCIAL PROBATION AND ATTENDANCE

WHY ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Attendance is the largest indicator of student success. Students learn better when they are in school. The skills and knowledge that they gain from classroom instruction prepare them to be able to navigate the challenges of life outside of the classroom.

WHAT IS SOCIAL PROBATION?

A student placed on Social Probation may not attend or participate in any extracurricular activities (including field trips, all VHSL activities, school dances, etc.) nor be on school property other than the regular school day.

SOCIAL PROBATION PROGRESSION

- 4 cumulative absences/6 cumulative tardies
 - Social Probation for First Quarter
- 8 cumulative absences/12 cumulative tardies
 - Social Probation for First Semester
- 12 cumulative absences/18 cumulative tardies
 - Social Probation through the end of the Third Quarter
- 16 cumulative absences/24 cumulative tardies
 - Social Probation for the remainder of the School Year

Students can recoup seat time during 8th Period for absences/tardies
